Bill Analysis

SB 1211 eliminates language providing for increased prison terms for subsequent convictions. The measure increases the maximum term of imprisonment for persons convicted of assault and battery by strangulation or attempted strangulation against an intimate partner or a family or household member to 10 years. A person convicted of assault and battery by strangulation or attempted strangulation shall serve a term of imprisonment of not less than 1 year and not more than 10 years.
