Bill Analysis

SB 1334 creates Corinne’s Law. The measure requires each health benefit plan offered in the state to provide coverage for medically necessary expenses relating to standard fertility preservation services if a medically necessary treatment will cause iatrogenic infertility and the patient is within reproductive age. Coverage shall include costs associated with storage of oocytes and sperm for a period not to exceed 3 years. The measure allows a health benefit plan to contain provisions for maximum benefits and to subject the covered service to the same deductible, copayment, coinsurance, and reasonable limitations and exclusions. Religious organizations are authorized to submit a written request for an exemption to these provisions to a carrier of a health benefit plan.

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
