**Bill Analysis**

SB 1347 specifies that a person operating a vehicle in motion may not use a hand-held electronic communication device or cellular telephone to compose a text message. Such persons are also prohibited from holding a cellular telephone. The measure specifies that the fine for violating this prohibition shall not exceed \$5.00 and court costs shall not exceed \$95.00. The measure apportions the total fine to the Sheriff's Service Fee Account, Office of the Attorney General, Child Abuse Multidisciplinary Account, the CLEET Fund, Forensic Science Improvement Revolving Fund, Department of Public Safety Patrol Vehicle Revolving Fund, Court Clerk's Revolving Fund, District Court Revolving Fund, and General Revenue Fund.
