Bill Analysis

SB 1377 directs the Institute for the Study of Free Enterprise at Oklahoma State University to continue at the same location as the School of Civic and Economic Thought and Leadership. The measure directs the school to operate as a stand-alone academic entity and directs the Board of Regents for Oklahoma Agricultural and Mechanical Colleges to allocate appropriate funding for the operations of the school. The bill directs the school by October 1, 2024, to electronically submit a report that includes information about funding, faculty positions, courses, student enrollment, and events, initiatives, or publications. It allows the chairs of the legislative committees with responsibility over higher education to request that the director of the school appear before their committees to report on the school's achievements.
