Bill Analysis

SB 1380 creates a tier 3 category for long-term administrators. A tier 3 care administrator is defined as a person licensed or certified by this state to perform the duties of an administrator serving in a residential care home or adult day care center. The measure authorizes the Commissioner of Health to require an AIT internship for Tier 2 administrators of an intermediate care facility for individuals with intellectual disabilities with sixteen or fewer beds (ICF/IID-16). Additionally, the measure authorizes a Registered Nurse or Licensed Practical Nurse performing duties in a nursing facility or specialized facility to prepare medications for administration to residents.

CCR Changes

The Conference Committee Report for SB 1380 completely replaces engrossed language with the language described above.

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
