Bill Analysis

SB 141 redesignates the Chair of the Long-Range Capital Planning Commission as the Capitol Liaison. The measure directs the Department of Public Safety to create a security plan for the Oklahoma State Capitol and Oklahoma State Capitol grounds and the Governor's Mansion and to submit the plan to the Capitol Preservation Commission for review and approval every 3 years. Proposals for enhancement, modification, preservation, or restoration of the Oklahoma State Capitol and Oklahoma State Capitol grounds, and the Governor's Mansion and grounds, shall be submitted to the Liaison. The Capitol Liaison shall be the primary liaison for all tenants that occupy space in the Oklahoma State Capitol. Oklahoma Management and Enterprise Services (OMES) shall serve as the primary contact for Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990 (ADA) compliance for the Oklahoma State Capitol. The measure eliminates the State Capitol Repair Expenditure Oversight Committee. Additionally, the measure modifies the membership of the State Capitol Preservation Commission.
