Bill Analysis

SB 141 redesignates the Chair of the Long-Range Capital Planning Commission as the Capitol Liaison. The Capitol Liaison is placed within Legislative Service Bureau. Additionally, the measure creates additional responsibilities for the position. The Liaison shall serve as the primary contact for Americans with Disabilities Act compliance within the Capitol. All proposals for enhancement, modification, preservation, or restoration of the Oklahoma State Capitol and Oklahoma State Capitol grounds, and the Governor's Mansion and grounds, shall be submitted to the Liaison. Parking spots and space allocation as well as security proposals shall also be submitted to the Liaison. The measure eliminates the State Capitol Repair Expenditure Oversight Committee.

Additionally, the measure modifies the membership of the State Capitol Preservation Commission. The measure directs the Department of Public Safety to create a security plan for the Oklahoma State Capitol and Oklahoma State Capitol grounds and the Governor's Mansion and to submit the plan to the Capitol Preservation Commission for review and approval every 3 years.
