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Bill Analysis

SB 1417 modifies provisions relating to reimbursement of long-term care facilities by the Oklahoma Health Care Authority. The measure provides that Medicaid long-term care providers may earn payment by achieving a 2-star rating long-stay quality measures rating. The measure provides that program funds shall be allocated at 40% (2-star), 60% (3-star), 80% (4-star), and 100% (5-star) of the per-day amount reserved for the quality assurance component per Medicaid patient day based on the rating of the provider. The measure directs the Oklahoma Health Care Authority to include a supplemental item reflecting the new state and federal funding necessary to meet the additional costs associated with reimbursing nursing facilities and intermediate care facilities for individuals with intellectual disabilities at the most recent audited cost.

CCR Changes

The Conference Committee Report for SB 1417 adds language relating to compensating facilities based on their rating. The CCR also adds language directing the Authority to include a supplemental item.

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
