Bill Analysis

SB 1418 strikes language further criminalizing any person engaging in an act of prostitution if such a person knows he or she has the human immunodeficiency virus (HIV). The measure provides that any person sentenced to this crime as well as spreading infectious diseases or knowingly engaging in conduct reasonably likely to transfer HIV may file a petition for resentencing or modification judgment and sentence before the trial court that entered the judgment of conviction.
