## **Bill Analysis**

SB 147 amends the Diabetes Management in Schools Act. The measure requires diabetes medical management plans to indicate whether the parent or legal guardian of a student with diabetes has given written consent for a school nurse, trained school employee, or volunteer diabetes care assistant to administer glucagon to a student experiencing a hypoglycemic emergency or if the student's prescribed glucagon is not available or has expired. The bill allows a school district board of education to elect to stock glucagon and adopt a related policy and states that written consent and a waiver of liability for administration of glucagon will be effective for the school year and must be renewed each subsequent school year. The measure allows a licensed physician to write a prescription for glucagon to a school district.
