Bill Analysis

SB 151 directs the Department of Public Safety to promulgate rules to implement a vehicle emissions inspection program that complies with established best practices. The program shall require a vehicle to pass the inspection every 2 years. Owners of the vehicle shall keep the certificate demonstrating the vehicle is in compliance with the testing requirements in their vehicles at all times. All vehicles requiring annual registration must participate in the program. Any person or entity selling a vehicle shall provide the most recent emissions inspection report at the time of sale. The provisions of this measure shall not apply to any vehicle manufactured prior to 1990 or electric vehicles.
