Bill Analysis

SB 1530 creates the Women's Bill of Rights. The measure specifies that any policy, program, or statute that prohibits discrimination based on sex shall be construed to forbid unfair treatment of females or males in relation to similarly situated members of the opposite sex. Distinctions may be made between the sexes if they are substantially related to an important government objectives. Additionally, the measure requires the state and any political subdivision collecting vital statistics to include the identification of any natural person who is part of the collected data as either male or female as defined in the measure.
