**Bill Analysis**

SB 1551 provides that a firearm suppressor manufactured and remaining in the state shall not be subject to federal law or federal regulation. The measure specifies that the basic material from which a firearm suppressor is manufactured is not subject to federal regulation under the authority of the United States Congress to regulate interstate commerce. Firearm suppressor manufactured and sold in the state must have the words "Made in Oklahoma" clearly stamped, machined, or engraved on it.
