Bill Analysis

SB 1575 extends the minimum time a person must appear in court for eviction proceedings after a summons is issued from 10 days to 10 business days after the issuance of the summons. The measure establishes that such summons shall not request the appearance of a person in court more than 15 days after the summons is issued. The measure requires the summons to be delivered at least 7 days before the scheduled hearing instead of 3 days before the hearing. The measure provides that the summons shall be delivered at least 3 or 5 days before certain trials.
