**Bill Analysis**

SB 1595 creates the Firearm Accessory Protection Act. The measure prohibits any peace officers from confiscating or enforcing any ban on the sale or possession of bump stocks, arm braces, or any other attachment or accessory added to a firearm. Individuals who were impeded in the sale or possession of such items shall have cause to file a civil action against the agency, department, or organization responsible for the impediment. The measure also adds firearm accessories and attachments to the list of items subject to regulation solely by the Legislature.
