**Bill Analysis**

SB 16 directs the State Board of Education to establish a two-year pilot program to provide grants to school districts and one technology center school site to provide child care for school district employees. It allows grants to be used to establish an on-site child care facility on school district property, contract with a child care facility, or provide stipends to employees to help cover a portion of child care-related expenses. It directs the Board to establish criteria for awarding grants. The bill also directs districts that receive grants to submit a report to the Board after completion of the two-year pilot program.
