## **Bill Analysis**

SB 1635 provides that a medical marijuana business licensee must submit an affidavit for license renewal after submitting a certificate of compliance to the Oklahoma Medical Marijuana Authority. The affidavit shall attest that the business continues to comply with zoning classifications, applicable municipal ordinances, and all applicable safety, electrical, fire, plumbing, waste, construction, and building specification codes. This provision shall not apply to a business licensee that submits a full and complete application for a valid certificate of occupancy to the State Fire Marshal or a political subdivision with an authority having a jurisdiction agreement on file with the State Fire Marshal before February 1, 2024. Licensees are responsible for compliance with applicable state codes. The measure also defines "final harvest batch" as well as "final product."

## **CCR Changes**

The Conference Committee Report for SB 1635 changes the month of November to February as it relates to agreements on file with the State Fire Marshal and accepts House Amendments. HA's modify provisions relating to licensees submitting a full and complete application for a valid certificate and defines "final harvest batch" as well as "final product."
