**Bill Analysis**

SB 1638 requires the report submitted to law enforcement relating to a child running away from or missing from foster placement to contain a photo depicting the missing child, a description of the missing child's physical features, and endangerment information. The measure requires the Department of Human Services to maintain regular communication with law enforcement and the National Center for Missing and Exploited Children to provide for the safe recovery of a missing or abducted child or youth.
