Bill Analysis

SB 1651 allows a school district board of education to accept students from a contiguous, out-of-state district without charging tuition if the receiving school district does not receive State Aid funds and has a per-pupil expenditure that is above the state average per-pupil expenditure. The measure clarifies that such out-of-state students are not eligible for State Aid, and no local funds from the out-of-state district are to be allocated or transferred to the receiving district.
