Bill Analysis

SB 1658 establishes a 12-year statute of limitations for the sexual abuse of a vulnerable adult. The measure provides that a person may be prosecuted at any time for child abuse, sexual abuse of a vulnerable adult, and child trafficking if the accused person has provided a confession or admission related to the crime. The measure also eliminates language requiring prosecution to commence within 3 years from the date on which the identity of the suspect is established by DNA testing.
