Bill Analysis

SB 1687 requires any agency receiving a requirement to adopt or submit to any new federal rule or regulation or change to an existing federal rule or regulation to send the federal rule or regulation by electronic mail to all members of the Legislature and the Governor. The Legislature may disapprove adoption of the new rule or regulation. If the Legislature does not approve the new rule or regulation, the agency shall not enforce or follow the new rule or regulation. The Governor may veto the Legislature's disapproval. State employees complying with the provisions of this measure shall be exempt from liability.
