Bill Analysis

SB 1725 provides that an individual who does not hold a license, permit, certification, or registration as a health care professional shall not be in violation of any health care professional practice act or other law or rule if that individual or agent provides care using indigenous and traditional healing therapies. Practitioners of such therapies may not present themselves as health care professionals. Such therapies shall not include surgery, setting fractures, prescribing or administering X or Gamma ray radiation, prescribing a prescription drug or device, recommending the interruption of a prescription, diagnosing a medical disease, forcefully moving joints, or having a felony conviction of any crime involving the intentional harm of another person or moral turpitude.
