**Bill Analysis**

SB 1730 prohibits any covered facility from performing or assisting in the social transition of a child in the custody of the facility. The measure prohibits such facilities from performing any gender-affirming therapy to a child in the custody of the facility unless the covered facility or agent has obtained the prior written informed consent of the child's parent or legal guardian as prescribed by the Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services and Department of Human Services. The measure clarifies that the parent or legal guardian of the child reserves the right to refuse consent to a social transition or gender-affirming therapy.
