Bill Analysis

SB 1770 provides that if a petitioner requests expungement of multiple offenses in one county and such expungements would qualify for expungement if processed sequentially, the request for multiple expungements may be considered in a single petition. The measure also provides that any previously expunged offense shall not be considered as a prior offense in determining whether another offense qualifies for an expungement. Additionally, if the court issues an order setting aside or vacating the judgment of conviction and dismisses the case with prejudice because of DNA testing, a copy of the order indicating the individual has been exonerated through DNA testing shall be submitted to the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation.
