SB 1835 authorizes the district attorney of a jurisdiction in which a person was convicted of an offense to file a motion in the district court to vacate or set aside a judgment of conviction at any time if clear and convincing evidence exists establishing that the defendant was convicted of an offense that the defendant did not commit.
