**Bill Analysis**

SB 1891 prohibits the amendment of a certificate of birth to change the biological sex designation of a person without an independently verified sex chromosome test whose results match the gender or biological sex the person is seeking change to or for which the person is seeking recognition. This shall not apply to persons with certain conditions or a biochemically verifiable disorder of sex development (DSD).
