Bill Analysis

SB 1921 modifies the Chase Morris Sudden Cardiac Arrest Prevention Act to require athletic coaches to annually complete training in first aid, cardiopulmonary resuscitation, and the use of an automated external defibrillator (AED). The measure also requires each public school to develop a sudden cardiac emergency plan. The bill modifies the Zachary Eckles and Luke Davis Automated External Defibrillators in Schools Act to direct school districts that make AEDs available in schools or on school property to use guidelines established by a nationally recognized organization in determining the placement and maintenance of the AED.
