Bill Analysis

SB 1975 creates the Citizen's Bill of Rights. The measure prevents any government or business from forcing any digital monetary system on the citizenry without providing equally viable and useful alternative options for the citizenry to obtain goods and services as well as using such a system to monitor or control the habits of the citizenry. The measure prohibits such entities from denying legitimately earned funds or removing such funds. Such entities are also prohibited from creating a database of the purchases or goods and services of individual citizens. The measure prohibits such entities from seizing a citizen's gold or silver without his or her permission. Financial institutions are prohibited from restricting the use or denying the transfer of funds based on a person's race, ethnicity, sex, gender, age, political party, party affiliations, interests, or personal medical decisions. No social credit system may be implemented. Governments and businesses are prohibited from requiring a person to take a medical procedure. Governments and businesses are prohibited from tracking or implementing a carbon credit score. The measure prohibits governments and businesses from tracking or prohibiting the use of private gardens. The measure prohibits the use of AI in biotechnology to make certain decisions and provides for any worker who lost his or her job due to AI to receive 6 months' pay and benefits.
