**Bill Analysis**

SB 1980 defines a hemp-driven cannabinoid product as a product that contains cannabinoids that are extracted from hemp or resin from hemp by physical or chemical means and is intended for administration to a consumer including, but not limited to, concentrates, oils, tinctures, edibles, pills, topicals, gels, creams, and other derivative forms. The measure provides that any product used to create such a product shall not be considered marijuana.
