Bill Analysis

SB 222 removes the requirement for the Governor to appoint members to the Oklahoma Board of Licensed Alcohol and Drug Counselors using a list provided by the Oklahoma Drug and Alcohol Professional Counselors Association, Oklahoma Substance Abuse Services Alliance, and the Oklahoma Citizen Advocates for Recovery and Treatment Association. Instead, the Governor is authorized to consider recommendations from a statewide organization representing alcohol and drug counselors, a state chapter of a national organization representing alcohol and drug counselors, a statewide organization representing individuals in recovery, or other groups or individuals in the state.
