Bill Analysis

SB 258 prohibits any railroad operating in the state from running, or permitting to be run, any train which is not traveling with at least 2 copies of the physical manifest documents nor shall any conductor, engineer, railroad management, or railroad or public transit employee run a train without tangible railroad identification. Any violation shall subject the person or corporation to a \$2,500.00-\$10,000.00 fine. A separate violation of this section shall occur each day a railroad is not in compliance. A gross violation of the provisions of this measure shall result in a one-time fine of up to \$250,000.00.
