**Bill Analysis**

SB 264 authorizes the Oklahoma Medical Marijuana Authority to create a petty cash fund. The measure establishes that the initial, nonrefundable application fee for medical marijuana processors shall be \$2,500.00 and provides that all submissions of grower applications, renewal processor applications, and renewal dispensary applications shall be accompanied by a remittance of a fee of \$2,500.00 as well. The measure provides that secret shoppers employed by the Authority may attempt to purchase medical marijuana or marijuana products in order to prove compliance with the Oklahoma Medical Marijuana and Patient Protection Act or any rule determined by the Authority. Additionally, the measure clarifies that secret shoppers shall not be required to fulfill licensing requirements for the purchase of medical marijuana products.
