Bill Analysis

SB 32X appropriates the following amounts to the Oklahoma Health Care Authority:

- 1) \$30 million to provide grant funding to providers for the one-time connection to the state-designated entity for health information exchange
- 2) \$47,767,458.00 to increase reimbursement to long-term care facilities by \$35.00 per day and reimbursement to intermediate care facilities for individuals with intellectual disabilities (ICF/IID) by \$17.00 per day
- 3) \$200 million for onetime funding to critical access hospitals and hospitals participating in the Supplemental Hospital Offset Payment Program.

Additionally, the measure requires the Authority to a plan for the disbursement of the funds listed in the measure by no later than July 31st, 2023, to the Senate and House Appropriation Chairs. The measure authorizes the Authority to request that receipt and expenditure of unanticipated federal funds awarded after July 1, 2023, be exempt from expenditure limitations and from budgetary limitations.
