Bill Analysis

SB 335 provides that elections held by a county, school district, technology center school district, municipality, fire protection district, or other political subdivision may hold primary elections on the second Tuesday of March in any year other than a presidential election year and on the date of the Presidential Preferential Primary election in a presidential election year. The measure also authorizes such elections to be held on second Tuesday of June or August in an odd-numbered year.
