Bill Analysis

SB 361 creates the Interstate Teacher Mobility Compact Act to facilitate the mobility of teachers through a collective regulatory framework amongst member states. It states that licensure under the compact only pertains to initial granting of a license or certificate. The measure directs each member state to define, compile, and update a list of licenses that the member state is willing to consider for equivalency and provides a process for licensure through the compact. The measure also directs the creation of the Interstate Teacher Mobility Compact Commission comprised of states that have enacted the compact. It provides for the commission's powers and duties, membership, meetings, and rule-making authority.
