Bill Analysis

SB 362 exempts any person who has obtained a criminal history record check for certification or employment in the immediately preceding 5 years from being required to have another record check done when applying for employment as a full-time teacher or substitute teacher. The measure states that a person seeking employment as a full-time teacher shall also provide a letter from a school district in which the teacher was employed. It removes language that provided exceptions to the record check requirements for certain individuals seeking certain school employment.
