Bill Analysis

SB 30X apportions funding from the general appropriations measure to the Department of Education in the following manner:

- 1) \$2,437,991,559.00 for Local and State-supported Financial Support of Public Schools
- 2) \$359,193,470.00 for Certified Employee Health Benefit Allowance
- 3) \$194,211,359.00 for Support Employee Health Benefit Allowance
- 4) \$35,000,000.00 for Teachers' Retirement Credit
- 5) \$45,190,000.00 for Purchase of Textbooks and Instructional Materials
- 6) \$14,000,000.00 for Alternative and High Challenge Education
- 7) \$3,770,000.00 to support Education Leadership Oklahoma
- 8) \$1,500,000.00 for the Advanced Placement Incentives
- 9) \$13,000,000.00 for the Reading Sufficiency Act
- 10) \$9,205,685.00 for the Required Assessments
- 11) \$2,000,000.00 for Teach for America
- 12) \$38,000.00 for Ag in the Classroom

31) \$25,775,827.00 for Payroll, Salaries or Wages Including Tax-sheltered Deferment Contracts and Longevity Payments Authorized by State Statutes Professional and Personal Services Contracts

32) \$31,840,048.00 Professional and Personal Services Contracts

32) \$3,908,491,664.00 for Other Operating Funds

33) \$1,825,621,183.00 for the Expenditure of Federal Funds

The measure also apportions \$4,119,369.00 to the School Consolidation Assistance Fund and \$4,226,799.00 to the Teachers' Retirement System Dedicated Revenue Revolving Fund.
