Bill Analysis

SB 372 removes the directive for the State Board of Pharmacy to specify the amount and type of drugs that may be maintained in an emergency medication kit and provides that the Board shall charge a one-time application fee for each facility. Additionally, the measure specifies that the Board shall not restrict the amount or type of drugs that may be maintained in an emergency medication kit. The amount and type of drugs to be maintained in an emergency medication kit shall be determined by the pharmacy in coordination with the facility.

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
