**Bill Analysis**

SB 426 specifies that the World Health Organization, the United Nations, and the World Economic Forum have no jurisdiction in the state and states that the state and its political subdivisions shall not be compelled to engage in the enforcement of, or any collaboration with the enforcement of, any requirements or mandates issued by such organizations. No requirement or mandate issued by such organizations shall be used as the basis for action nor shall such a requirement or mandate be used to supersede state law.

**CCR Changes**

The Conference Committee Report for SB 426 completely replaces engrossed language with the language described above.
