## **Bill Analysis**

SB 429 allows a student enrolled in a public school district, charter school, or technology center school to wear tribal regalia on school property or at any school function. The measure also allows a student enrolled in a public institution of higher education to wear tribal regalia on the institution's campus or at any institution function and allows a school district board of education, the governing board of a charter school, the governing board of a technology center school, and the board of regents of an institution of higher education to adopt a policy to specify the characteristics of any garment, jewelry, or other adornment or object the school or institution finds will endanger the safety of a student or others.
