**Bill Analysis**

SB 437 directs the Health Care Authority to create and maintain a registry of recommending physicians as it relates to medical marijuana. Any physician recommending the use of medical marijuana must be listed on the registry beginning January 1, 2025. Physicians on the registry must comply with the medical education and continuing medical education requirements as promulgated by the Authority. Additionally, the measure requires employees of a medical marijuana business to comply with the education and continuing education requirements promulgated by the Authority as well.
