Bill Analysis

SB 476 provides that a felon who has previously been convicted of a nonviolent felony and completed the entirety of the sentence imposed for the offense and for a period of 5 years since the completion of the sentence has had no additional misdemeanor or felony offense convictions or charges pending shall have the right to transport, possess, and carry a firearm. Such rights shall be forfeited upon conviction of a subsequent misdemeanor or felony. Certain nonviolent offenses are excluded from the provisions of this measure.
