**Bill Analysis**

SB 481 adds election officials as it relates to the crime of threatening, intimidating, harassing, or doxing certain persons. The measure also authorizes the Secretary of the State Election Board to promulgate rules to keep confidential the residence and mailing address of the secretary, assistant secretary, employees, and members of a county election board or the State Election Board. The measure specifies that any person who utters or addresses any threat or intimidation to any election official or impersonates such an official, shall be deemed guilty of a felony.
