**Bill Analysis**

SB 495 prohibits the Legislature, state agency, department, or commission from implementing a mandate unless a specific appropriation is made to fund the political subdivision for all costs related to the mandate. Any unfunded mandate shall be deemed unenforceable. Any financial impact of any size determined to exist by the political subdivision shall be sufficient to deem as an unfunded mandate, excepting clerical work, office supplies, and creating and submitting reports.
