Bill Analysis

SB 503 prohibits any political subdivision from allowing or permitting a public display of lewd acts or obscene material in a public place including but not limited to parades, shows, concerts, plays, or any other activity where a minor could witness. Lewd behavior is defined in the measure as any sexual behavior imitating sex or sexual acts, groping, indecent exposure of genitalia or sexual paraphernalia, display of replicas of genitalia, sexually touching oneself or someone else, or convincing or forcing someone else to sexually touch or observe sexual behavior. Any individual intentionally displaying lewd acts or obscene material in front of a minor shall be guilty of a felony and shall be subject to civil action by any person who witnesses the individual.
