Bill Analysis

SB 504 provides that a distributed energy resource (DER) utility shall not have condemnation authority nor shall it be subject to the provisions of the Retail Electric Supplier Certified Territory Act. A DER utility is defined as any company that produces, delivers, or furnishes retail electric current for light, heat, or power to a customer through a power purchase agreement with a customer using power generated on the customer's property. In no case shall generation exceed 30% of the previous annual load of the customer. The provisions of this measure shall remain in effect until November 1, 2033.

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
