Bill Analysis

SB 560 defines coercive control as it relates to child custody. The measure provides that coercive control shall mean intentional isolation of a person, deprivation of basic necessities, control or regulation of a person's movements, compulsion of a person to engage in acts he or she has the right to abstain from, the act of committing or threatening to commit acts of cruelty on an animal, and demands on a person that limit free will.
