**Bill Analysis**

SB 625 prohibits any parent from permitting a child to possess a firearm if he or she believes the child shall use the firearm for purposes other than hunting animals or fowl, hunter safety classes, education and training in the safe use and handling of firearms, target shooting, skeet, trap, or other sporting events or competitions. Permitting a child to possess a firearm shall include the act of a person leaving a firearm unsecured and accessible to a child who takes, obtains, or possesses the firearm that harms the child or another person.
