**Bill Analysis**

SB 628 creates the Grandfathered Clause Act. The measure prohibits any person, partnership, association, or corporation, either for himself, herself, or itself, or in a representative or fiduciary capacity, to mandate any employee as a condition of continued employment to submit to or take any vaccination or medication that has received accelerated approval from the United States Food and Drug Administration or has been approved by the United States Food and Drug Administration for less than 5 years for the prevention of COVID-19.
