Bill Analysis

SB 633 defines “massage therapy establishment” as it relates to the Massage Therapy Practice Act and requires such establishments to first obtain a license prior to the operation of such an establishment. The measure also authorizes the State Board of Cosmetology and Barbering to offer temporary work permits as well as inspect establishments and establish minimum sanitation standards. The measure also provides for certain members to be appointed to the Board for established terms. The measure establishes a 500-credit hour minimum for persons seeking to be licensed by the Board. Massage therapy licenses shall be renewed every 2 years. The measure establishes a \$10.00 fee for the renewal of the license.
